



Who are we?

The Prophet Elijah Foundation was established by the Greek Catholic Youth Brotherhood „Sarepta”, which has been operating for 40 years. Due to the wide scope of its operation, the Brotherhood decided to focus on educational and cultural activities, such as museum and exhibition activities including icon writing workshops that have been taking place for many years. In other words, the foundation's goal is to protect cultural heritage, develop education and provide help to those in need, in particular representatives of national, ethnic and religious minorities living in Poland.

Our goals:

We organise various cultural, educational and social events. We strive to preserve, develop and promote the culture, art and spirituality of national, ethnic and religious minorities, in particular the Lemko people. We provide assistance to educational institutions that are involved in the education of children and youth. We implement charity initiatives and provide help to people in difficult life and financial situations. We also support medical facilities and hospitals.

Our first project is to renovate and transform the historic cottage in Komańcza into a center of Lemko culture. The cottage will be used for exhibitions and for various cultural events, concerts, workshops and meetings, promoting the history and culture of the Lemko region. It will also be a center of integration for the local community. We anticipate close cooperation with our strategic partners, such as the Council of Komańcza, the Iconart Foundation, the Cathedral of Sacred Art in Lviv and the Open-Air Museum in Sanok, to jointly implement various projects in the field of culture, education and cultural heritage.

Why Elijah?

The Prophet Elijah is a biblical figure, considered one of the most important for the followers of Judaism and Christians. His life was righteous and full of courage and action for good peace and justice. Elijah is also associated with the miracle in Zarephath, which is an inspiration for our foundation in undertaking difficult initiatives. The miracle at Zarephath is one of the most famous events in the life of Elijah. The Prophet asked a poor widow for a meal, and although she herself had only a little flour and oil, she agreed to feed him. When she did this, her supplies did not run out and allowed her to survive difficult times. This miracle proves that difficult initiatives undertaken in faith and trust in God produce positive results. It is an inspiration for us to engage in activities for others despite all adversities.
